



John 'Joe' Joseph Baud

March 15, 1918 - March 30, 2017

John "Joe" Joseph Baud, 99, of Mooresville, passed away on Thursday, March 30, 2017. He was born on March 15, 1918 in Dorchester, MA, to the late Percy John and Mary E. Baud. Joe was the third of eight children. Shortly after birth, the family moved to Camden, New Jersey, where he was raised and educated. In 1939, Joe married the love of his life, Dora E. (Smitley) Baud in Wyandotte, Michigan. During WWII, he served as a 2nd Lieutenant in the US Army Air Corps, as a bombardier on the B-29. In 1957, Joe moved his family to Las Vegas, where he and his wife owned and operated small motels. In the late 1970's, they retired and traveled extensively. He liked to say that they had been everywhere except Australia and Antarctica, many places more than once. He was preceded in death by his parents, all of his siblings, wife Dora, daughter Sharon (Baud Lamb) Caldwell, and son John J "Jack" Baud, Joe is survived by his only grandchild Richard Lamb, of Las Vegas, nephew and primary caregiver Ed Baud and his wife Sandy of Mooresville, NC, and more than a dozen nieces and nephews scattered around the country. A Memorial Service and placement of the ashes will occur at the convenience of the family.
