Johnny Ray Hayes, 75, of Mooresville, passed away on Friday, April 9, 2021, at Gordon Hospice House, Statesville. Born December 25, 1945, in Iredell County, he was the son of the late Alfred R. Hayes, Jr. and Betty Sherrill Hayes. Mr. Hayes was a 1965 graduate of Troutman High School. He worked as a Court Room Clerk for the Iredell County Clerk of Court for 34 years. Mr. Hayes served on the Alcohol Beverage Commission for 13 years. He also worked as a scoreboard operator for the Mooresville Recreation Department, school bus driver for the Iredell-Statesville Schools and kept stats for the Mooresville Football team. He was a member of First Baptist Church, Mooresville, where he enjoyed going on Mission Trips with the church. Mr. Hayes was preceded in death by his wife, Lori Adelina Constance Hayes and a sister, Eugenia Ponda Lambert. He is survived by his daughter, Stacey H.
