Julian D'Amico, Jr., 86, of Mooresville, NC, passed away on Saturday, June 29, 2019, at Gordon Hospice House, Statesville after suffering from lung cancer. He was born October 11, 1932, in Elberton GA, to the late Julian D'Amico and Cora Lee Wylie D'Amico. He is also preceded in death by a son, Joseph D'Amico and two brothers and two sisters.
