Julie Ann Haigler, 71, of Concord, NC, entered her new eternal home with Jesus on Sunday, October 15, 2023, surrounded by her family.

She was born on September 3, 1952 in Cabarrus County, NC, to the late Edsel Connell Haigler and Peggy Ferguson Haigler Alexander. She was a lifetime resident of Concord and lived in the home she was raised. Julie graduated from Concord High School, Rowan Community College with an Associate's Degree in Early Childhood Education, and Western Carolina University with a Bachelor's Degree in Special Education. She taught in Cabarrus County Schools, Rowan-Salisbury School District, and retired from Kannapolis City Schools after 27 years with the state.

She was a member of Kannapolis Pilot Club since 1998 and served in many leader positions from her local club to district officer, culminating as Governor of NC District of Pilot International in 2007-2008. She served as a Sunday School teacher, choir member, and VBS volunteer in various churches she attended. She was the primary caregiver for her mother.
