Justin Allen Parker, 31, of Cleveland, NC passed away on Saturday, October 31, 2015 at Lake Norman Regional Medical Center. Justin was a 2003 graduate of South Iredell High School and wheeled across the stage with a well-deserved standing ovation for his accomplishments. He was the first poster child in Iredell County for Muscular Dystrophy Association for the Harley Owners Group out of Tilley Harley Davidson of Statesville, where he is a lifetime member of the H.O.G. Club. Justin was a real talker and made friends everywhere he went. He developed several interests and hobbies throughout his life and was always looking for a job. He wanted to help support his family. Justin tried dog washing, riding horses, electronic repair, computer guru and all around source of information. And let's don't forget fly killing. He often sat in the Blacksmith shop in Love Valley and killed flies for his Uncle Charlie for 5 cents a fly. What an entrepreneur! The impact this young man made on so many lives, as he wheeled through our hearts, had to have been God's purpose in sending him to us. He has been such an inspiration to so many people. While dealing with pain, in a capacity few of us can understand, he met each day with a smile and love in his heart for everyone. He was a member of Troutman Baptist Church.
