



Kathleen Crawford Campbell

November 25, 1928 - April 25, 2016

Kathleen Crawford Campbell, 87, of Huntersville, passed away on Monday, April 25, 2016. She was born on November 25, 1928 in Liverpool, England, to the late Andrew Crawford and Lillian Gratton Crawford. She spent her childhood in London, England except for a brief period during WWII when she lived with relatives on a farm in Kirk-Smeaton. After the war she worked at the Dorchester hotel in London and travelled extensively throughout Europe. In the early 1950s, Kathleen moved to Montreal, Canada where her sister Barbara resided at the time. In the late 1950's Kathleen moved to Jamaica, where she worked as an event and catering manager for the Jamaica Inn resort hotel. It was in Jamaica where she met her future husband, Nevil Arthur Campbell and settled to raise a family of her own. She lived in Jamaica until 1978 when the family moved to the U.S. to live in Orlando, Florida.

Kathleen worked as the event and catering manager for the Gold Key Inn in Orlando until she retired in 1995. She continued to live in the Orlando area until 2011 when she moved to Huntersville, NC to be near her eldest son.

Kathleen was a dedicated wife and mother who through her will, determination, and sacrifice enabled her family to emigrate to the US for her children to have the opportunity of a better future. Her children and grandchildren are a testimony to her life.

Kathleen is survived by her sister, Barbara Krey; her children Nigel, Ian, and Corinne; grandchildren Jackie, Robert Jr., and Ryan.

A memorial service will be held at Olde Knox Commons nursing home (13825 Hunton Lane, Huntersville, NC) at 2:00 PM on Friday April 29th.
