Kitty was a Valedictorian graduate of Pelahatchie High School, and she received a B.S. degree from the University of Southern Mississippi. A dedicated teacher and after-school program administrator/coordinator, she retired from Mooresville Graded School District after 22 years of service.

A loving mother and devoted wife, Kitty was also an avid reader who loved cross-word puzzles and to read books to her grandchildren.
