Kay Frances Bowles, 81, of Mooresville, passed away on Monday, January 12, 2015 at the Gordon Hospice House in Statesville.

She worked for the Mooresville High School for over 51 years as a financial secretary, where the Class of 2014 dedicated their yearbook, *The Pitchfork*, to her. She was a member of Southside Baptist Church in Mooresville, where she served as the Sunday School secretary.
