



Kenneth Allen Sweeney

April 19, 1943 - December 18, 2015

Kenneth Allen Sweeney (Ken), 72, of Maiden, NC, passed away on December 18, 2015, at the Levine & Dickson Hospice House in Huntersville, NC. Ken was the son of the late Edward & Iva Sweeney. He was born on April 19, 1943, in Dover, NJ. He was a graduate of Roxbury High School, attended the County College of Morris, and was a graduate of the New Jersey State Police Academy. Ken was a part of the Roxbury Township police force for 15 years. He served as a patrolman for 10 years, a Detective for 2 years and retired as a Detective Sergeant in 1983. He was a Fireman for 10 years at the Roxbury Fire Company #3. He served on the Roxbury Township council from 1988 to 1991; he was part of the Morris County Republican Committee Ward 2 District 1 in 1988, and the Mayor of Roxbury Township in 1990. Ken was a lifetime member of the Roxbury Township Police Benevolent Association, as well as a member of IASIU, IAAI, NCICIE and SCIFI. He was a former coach and manager of the Roxbury Midget Football and Lassie League teams. Ken married Anne Cummings on December 15, 1962, in Chatham, NJ. They were happily married for 53 years. Ken was a beloved husband, father and grandfather. His greatest joy over the past couple of years was driving and working on his 1941 Ford Super Deluxe nicknamed "Raggmopp". He also enjoyed watching football and playing golf. He is survived by his wife, Anne, of Maiden, NC. His children, Kelly Bruno, of Denver, NC, Tracy and husband, Allan Brucato, of Andover, NJ, Kevin Sweeney, of Maiden, NC, and his granddaughter, Taira and husband, Allen Pruitt, of Troutman, NC. His

brothers, Larry and wife, Debra Sweeney, of Sunset Beach, NC, Gary Sweeney, of Succasunna, NJ, and his sister, Linda and husband, Douglas Scherzer, of Calabash, NC; as well as with many cousins, nieces and nephews.
