Dr. Kenneth Anthony Koontz, 74, of Mooresville, passed away on November 4, 2017 at his residence. He was born on October 28, 1943 in Pittsburg, PA, to the late Bernard and Estelle Kedzierski Koontz. Dr. Koontz served proudly as Captain in the US Army. He received his Doctorate from University of Pittsburg and was a dentist in Charlotte. He was a member of St. Therese Catholic Church in Mooresville, where he served as an usher, Eucharistic minister, and was a member of the Knights of Columbus. Kenny adored his wife of 51 years finding her in the 7th grade. He led a life of great faith and gave humbly and selflessly to others.
