In the fall of 2024, life brought Lacie another unexpected gift: a lifelong friend. On the sidelines of a youth football field, she met Kelsey Crowdes while their husbands, Nick and Joe, coached their sons together. Lacie and Kelsey

bonded instantly, quickly becoming inseparable. From daily phone calls about what the kids were doing, to venting about their husbands, to debating the plays that should've been called in the last game, they shared everything.
