Larry Kent Baker, 84, of Mooresville, passed away on Friday, February 22, 2019, surrounded by his family at Gordon Hospice House in Statesville, after a short illness.

He was born July 24, 1934 in Mooresville, NC, the only child born to Frank E. and Lois Shook Baker. Larry graduated from Mooresville High School in 1952. He worked in various radio stations in North and South Carolina as a Disc Jockey after graduation. He served in the US Army in 1957 at Cape Canaveral, FL, in the early space program. He was called to active duty in 1963 during the "Berlin crisis". He received an associate degree and did work in sales and marketing at Central Piedmont Community College, Charlotte, NC and retired from VCR repair business in 1996.

Larry is survived by his loving wife of 65 years, Patricia Baker; daughters, Beverly Fisk (Kevin) of Garner, NC and Joy Leonard (Richard) of Bakersfield, CA; grandchildren, Jason Fisk, Annie Fisk, Daniel Spaulding and Rae Ellen Overcash.
