Larry Allen Beaver, 78, of Mooresville, NC passed away on Wednesday, February 19, 2020 at his home surrounded by his family and friends.

Larry was born November 14, 1941 in Iredell County to the late George Augustus Beaver and Lucy Anderson Beaver Corriher. He graduated from West Rowan High School. Larry was the President/Owner of Tarheel Electric Company in Mooresville and a life time member of the Carolina Electrical Contractors Association, serving on the board for many years. He was a member of St. Mark's Lutheran Church in Mooresville serving on the church council and providing help to the church in many ways.

Larry loved his wife, his daughters and grandchildren more than words can say. He enjoyed attending and supporting them in all their sporting activities; he was their #1 fan and hero. He enjoyed coaching and supporting friends of his daughters and grandchildren as well. Larry didn't have any sons but devoted his time coaching a Pony league baseball team, the Cardinals, for several years. He was truly an avid sports competitor.
