She was a retired dental hygienist. Laurie was a champion for the underprivileged and was very active in the Mooresville community and her church. She served on the Mooresville Community Housing board, volunteered at The Give Back Boutique and was a member of the Board of Trustees at Fairview United Methodist Church. Laurie had empathy and compassion for everyone, especially the less fortunate.
