Margaret Lee Hager Armstrong of Davidson, passed away on Sunday, December 22, 2024, at the S. Mitchell Mack Hospice House in Mooresville. Born on Monday, April 5, 1926, she was blessed with 98 years of life.

Margaret was a long-time member of Hopewell Baptist Church in Davidson and was an active member of The Homemakers Sunday School Class, and attended regularly until her declining health. She worked for many years at Mooresville Mills (Burlington) and retired from Elox Corporation in Davidson after more than 30 years.

After retirement, she kept her great-grandchildren and great-great grandchildren in her home. With more love to give, she also worked part-time in the nursery at Mt. Zion Church in Cornelius, Northcross Lanes (now Sparetime) in Huntersville, and at River Run Tennis Courts in Davidson. She kept children occasionally in their homes, and even her own home.
