Margaret Ruth Migdol Schenone, 78, of Mooresville, passed away on Monday, March 31, 2025 at Novant Health Huntersville Medical Center. After battling Pancreatic Cancer Margie gently left for Heaven while she was surrounded by her family.

She was born on August 1, 1946 in New Jersey, to the late Andrew and Edna Martin Migdol. Margie Schenone was a member of St. Therese Catholic Church in Mooresville. She loved children and watched many through the years.

She was a Cub Scout Den mom, attended numerous school trips with her sons, and she was an active member of the Harley Owners Group Organization for 25 years. During her tenure with the Harley Organization, she helped raise money for many charities. Margie was heavily involved with the motorcycle clubs Guardians of The Children and Sentinels of Hope. Both organizations stand up for abused children and mothers in need. Margie also supported the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation and the Hospice Foundation.

Margie is survived by her husband, Richard R. Schenone for 57 years; sons, Richard R. Schenone II and wife Maria, Peter A. Schenone and wife Daisy; her granddaughters, Brianna, Victoria, Angelina; and numerous extended family.

Margie had such a beautiful passion for not only raising her 2 sons Richard and Peter, 3 grandchildren Brianna, Victoria, and Angelina. In addition, she raised and cared for Rachael and Sarah who all grew in Margie's heart until the very end.
