Marion Autin McConnell, 92, of Mooresville, passed away on Tuesday, January 9, 2024 at S. Mitchell Mack Hospice House in Mooresville.

She was born on November 2, 1931, in Liberty, Texas and spent her early adulthood in New Orleans, LA where she taught dance at Marion's School of Dancing before moving to Charlotte, NC in 1959. She was the daughter of the late Lawrence and Florence Louviere Autin. She was a member of Triplett Church in Mooresville, NC, and the Newell Chapter #344 Order of the Eastern Star, from which she received her 25 year service pin on May 22, 1986. Mrs. McConnell continued to demonstrate her love of dance throughout her life and actively participated in both recreational and competitive line dancing activities, some of which won statewide distinction in the Senior Olympic games. Marion also had a passion for caring for animals.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, George Lewis McConnell; brother, Lawrence Autin, Jr.; and granddaughter, Shelley Rose McConnell.
