August 30, 1957 - March 24, 2025

Mark Steven Brady, 67, of Mooresville, NC, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 24, 2025, at Atrium Health Cabarrus in Concord.

Born on August 30, 1957, in Manchester, TN, Mark was the loving son of James Arlon Brady and Georgia Mozelle Lester Brady. He graduated from East Carolina University in 1979, earning his Bachelor's Degree.

Mark dedicated his professional life to the banking industry, serving as Senior Vice President and City Executive for First Reliance Bank in Mooresville. His commitment to community service was profound; he was an elder at Shearer Presbyterian Church and a passionate supporter of local initiatives. Mark's influence extended to various organizations, including his long-standing roles as President and veteran member of the South Iredell Community Development Corporation, member of the Iredell County Economic Development Corporation, founding board member of the YMCA, United Way; and participant in the Planning and Zoning Board for the Town of Mooresville. His impact was felt through his contributions to the Lake Norman Homebuilders Association, Mooresville Christian Mission, and the Mooresville-Lake Norman Rotary Club, where he also served as past President. Mark was a guiding force as Chairman and board member of the Mooresville-South Iredell Chamber of Commerce and championed many efforts to improve the community he loved.

Mark is survived by his devoted wife of 24 years, Deborah Crowder Brady; his sons, Erik and Justin; one granddaughter; and his cherished Irish terrier, Wizard. He was preceded in death by his brother, James "Jim" Brady.

A Celebration of Life service will be held at 6 PM on Thursday, April 3, 2025, at the Heritage House of Cavin-Cook Funeral Home in Mooresville, where family and friends will gather to honor Mark's legacy and reflect on the profound impact he made on those around him. Rev. Dr. Stephen Stout will officiate the service, providing comfort and remembrance of a life well-lived. The family will receive friends following the service in the Heritage House.

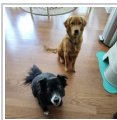
