Martha Sloop Millsaps, 91, of Mooresville, passed away on Thursday, July 6, 2017 at her residence. She was born on March 6, 1926 in Mooresville, NC, to the late Pearl Cowan Sloop and Fary Edmiston Sloop Barnhardt. Mrs. Millsaps was a homemaker known for her handwork skills. One of her proudest accomplishments was crocheting over 3000 lap robes for the folks in local rest homes. At the time, she was in her 70s and 80s.
