



Martha Ann Ware

December 16, 1935 - August 24, 2021

Martha Ann Craven Ware, age 85, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, August 24, 2021. After surviving Covid in January and dealing with the death of her husband Brohn in January 2021, her health never fully recovered. After a number of months of declining health, she died peacefully in the Gordon Hospice House.

She was born on December 16, 1935 to Rowland Pharr Craven and Loy Elizabeth McLean Craven. She was raised in the community of Coddle Creek and was the youngest of 8 siblings. She had fond memories of attending Coddle Creek ARP Church. She often spoke fondly of its families and the gatherings.

Martha Ann attended Mooresville High School and after graduation moved to Charlotte to work for Aetna Life Insurance. It was during this period that she met and married her husband of 66 years Brohn Edward Max Ware.

Martha Ann was a homemaker and mother in Charlotte, North Carolina. She was a loving and devoted wife and mother. She loved people and engaging in conversation with those from all walks of life. She enjoyed the art of creating flower arrangements and was active in the community garden clubs often entering her arrangements in the Charlotte flower shows.

She was a follower of the Jesus Christ and a member of Centre Presbyterian Church, where until her health declined, she was active in Sunday school and worship.

She was predeceased by her parents, her husband, Brohn, and siblings Marybeth Craven Morrison Kennedy, Rebecca Craven Mills, Juliet "Judy" Craven Brown, Sarah McClellan Craven Washam, Myrtle Evelyn Craven Sims, and William Thomas "Tommy" Craven.

Martha is survived by her brother Walter P. Craven and her children John Emory Ware (Audrey), Jeffery Lynn Ware, and William Edward Ware (Myung Hee); and one grandchild, Brennan Renee Ware.
