Mary Harvey Holshouser Fortanbary, passed away on Monday, June 15th at Autumn Care of Cornelius, NC.

She was born April 19, 1939 in Union, SC, the daughter of the late Harvey Clarence Holshouser and Mary Elizabeth Holshouser.
