Mary Agnes Jackson Wiggins, 93 years old, of Mooresville, passed away on Sunday, October 23, 2022.

She was born in Mooresville, NC, on November 9, 1928 to Claud Elijah Jackson and Ethel Sechler Jackson. Mary Agnes graduated from Landis High School in 1947, where she was a cheerleader. She was employed by Harris Teeter from the time she was a girl until she retired in the early 1970's. For the next 50 years she sold Avon, enjoying the interactions with all her customers. Mary Agnes was a lifelong member of Prospect Presbyterian Church in Mooresville. She loved horses and any thing "western"; she and her husband, Carl, participated with their horses and buggies in many Christmas parades. She also enjoyed flower gardening.
