Michael John Volovski, Jr (Mike) of Mooresville, NC, formerly of Altoona, PA, entered into the presence of his Lord and Saviour on May 23, 2026.

He was born on May 27, 1935, to Michael and Violet (Cline) Volovski, Sr. in York County, Pennsylvania.

He was married to Amy Lou (Bracker) Volovski almost 70 Years (June 23rd). In addition to his wife, he is survived by his two children, Jon M. (Jane Elkovich) Volovski of Mooresville, NC, and Rebecca A. (David) Harner of Collegeville, PA; 8 grandchildren, 4 great grandchildren; and his brother, Robert (Rita) Volovski of Casselberry, FL.

The turning point of Mike's life came at the age of 16, when he gave his life to Jesus Christ as his personal Savior. That led Mike into a quest for learning and studying the Bible. Mike became a pastor and a professor of Biblical languages. Later he and Amy moved to Central African Republic as missionaries. They lived in Africa for 16 years, where Mike taught young Bible students Hebrew, Greek and Aramaic in French, preparing them for pastoral ministry. Mike's journey of learning began in a one room country schoolhouse, and continued through several colleges and seminaries, resulting in his earning 3 master's degrees and a doctorate. God used all of this in Mike's life in the training of many students for His glory and honor.

His passion for studying God's Word never ended. In his retirement years he enjoyed his continued studies in Biblical languages. He spent much time translating Scripture from Greek, Hebrew, and Aramaic into the English language for his own translation.

The family will receive friends on Saturday, May 30 from 2:00-3:00 PM with his Celebration of Life Service following at 3:00 PM at Trinity Baptist Church, 221 Ervin Rd, Mooresville, NC. 28117 with Pastor Mark Harris officiating.
