Moody Bane "Bane" Shaw Jr., 82, of Mooresville and formerly of Charlotte, NC, passed away peacefully on Monday, April 7, 2025. A beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend, Bane lived his life with boundless energy, joy, and love for those around him.

Born and raised in Charlotte, Bane developed a lifelong passion for tennis early on. He graduated from East Carolina College (now East Carolina University) with a Bachelor of Arts in Chemistry. While there, he was a four-year letterman for the ECU Pirates tennis team and proudly served as team captain his senior year.

Bane proudly served his country in the U.S. Army, where he earned the rank of Captain before being honorably discharged. His leadership and integrity carried into every chapter of his life.

A fixture on the courts at Olde Providence Racquet Club, Bane formed deep friendships over countless matches. He also found joy and camaraderie on the waters of Lake Norman, where he was a longtime member of the Lake Norman Yacht Club. There, he not only sailed with passion but also gave back to the club-mentoring new sailors and serving with distinction as Commodore. His enthusiasm and warmth left a lasting impact on all who knew him at the club.

Off the court and away from the water, Bane cherished the quiet moments-sitting on the back deck with his loyal dog by his side, listening to music, sipping his signature dark and stormy, and enjoying the company of family and friends. His laughter and stories brought light to every gathering, and his unwavering loyalty made him the heart of many cherished friendships.

A proud and passionate ECU football fan, Bane rarely missed a home game, sharing the experience season after season with a close-knit group of fellow fans.

Bane leaves behind a legacy of love, laughter, and loyalty. He is survived by his devoted wife of 57 years, Doris Ann Hoover Shaw; his sons, Ashley Shaw and wife Heather and Tim Shaw and wife Katie; and his beloved grandchildren, Bradley, Blakely, Alexis, and Kappy. He is also survived by his sister, Jane Massey, her husband Jim, and their children, Clayton and wife Holly and daughter Alena; and Trudy and daughter Fritz.

Bane's warmth, generosity, and unforgettable presence touched countless lives. He will be deeply missed and fondly remembered by all who had the privilege of knowing him.

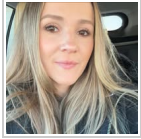
