Mrs. Nancy Moore Wilson, 85, of Mooresville, passed away Saturday morning, January 16, at Lake Norman Regional Medical Center.

Nancy was born on March 25, 1930. She was the daughter of the late William Vance Moore and Della Boggs Moore. Nancy moved to Mooresville with her widowed mother, sister, and brother as a high school senior. She lived her entire life in the home her family bought shortly after coming to Mooresville. Nancy was a skilled seamstress and quilter. For several years, she was part owner and proprietor of Three Little Women, a local shop specializing in smocking, decorative flag, and quilting supplies and classes. Her children and grandchildren were the lucky recipients of many of Granny's lovely custom made quilts and crafts.

Nancy is survived by three daughters: June Lane (husband Bill), Donna McMillan (husband Robin), and Barbara Howard (husband David); six granddaughters, three grandsons, and twelve great-grandchildren.

She is survived by one sister Rosalie Moore Crouch (husband Marshall) and one brother Charles Kent Moore (wife Jackie) and many nieces and nephews. Nancy was preceded in death by her husband Cecil Brown Wilson.
