Noah Lynn Appleton died peacefully, but unexpectedly, at his home in Mooresville with his wife of 20 years, Brigitte, by his side. Born in Marshall, TX, he was a son of the late Noah W. and Gladys Winn Appleton. After graduating from Baylor University in Waco, TX, Noah joined the United States Naval Aviation Officer Candidate Program, to become an Aircraft Carrier Flight Instructor. Until his honorable discharge in 1971, he proudly served his country as a Naval Aviator, and insisted it was one of the most significant and rewarding chapters of his life. In business, he sought to hire veterans as often as possible, and he showed special appreciation to military clients. Noah was a longtime owner of "Advantage BMW Downtown" in Houston, TX and Tuffy Auto Service Center in Mooresville. Noah's kindness, compassion, and humility were evident to every life he touched, including family, friends, and employees. He generously supported numerous charities and foundations, including Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, Humane Society, Citizen's for Animal Protection (CAP), SPCA, SEARCH Houston (for the Homeless), American Heart and Alzheimer's Associations.
