Pam Beaver, daughter of Grant William Bolmer and Dorothy Wrenn Bolmer Richards, died on September 14, 2022. Pam was born in Louisburg, NC, on November 11, 1943. From the age of four, Pam lived in Mooresville where her father was a lawyer and judge. Pam had wonderful memories and lifelong friends from Park View Elementary, Mooresville Junior High and Mooresville High School. After high school, Pam graduated from Catawba College and began teaching English at South Rowan High School. While working as a teacher and guidance counselor at South, Pam finished a master's degree at UNC-Charlotte. After she became Director of Programs for Exceptional Children for the Rowan County Schools in 1979, she earned a Doctorate in Education from UNC-Greensboro. For over thirty years, "Doc" also worked as Assistant Principal at West Rowan High School, EC Director and Curriculum Specialist for the Mooresville Graded School District. Pam was first married to Allen Robertson who died at age 21. She was then married to Richard (Rudy) Beaver for 54 years.
