Paul Vincent Kelly, 89, of Mooresville, passed away on Sunday, May 29, 2016 at ContinueCare Hospital in Pineville. He was born on June 10, 1926 in New Jersey, to the late John Paul Kelly and Augusta Ruckert Kelly. Mr. Kelly was a WWII veteran serving in the US Army and received his Bachelor Science degree in Math from the University of Vermont. He was owner/operator of Piedmont Heat Treating, Inc. in Charlotte. Mr. Kelly was a lifetime member of the American Society of Metals and the Metal Treating Institute. He loved his family and was a true man's man.
