Greensboro – Rachel Sloop Brawley died on December 28, 2018 at Friends' Homes of Guilford in Greensboro. Rachel was born at her home in Iredell County, NC in 1921. She was the daughter of the late Lon G. and Minnie Poole Sloop. She was a graduate of Mooresville High School. She then attended the Lowrance Hospital School of Nursing in Mooresville. After graduating, she obtained her Registered Nurse certification. She was a dedicated Nursing professional for over 40 years. She spent the last 18 of her retirement years at Friends Home Guilford in Greensboro, NC.
