Rebecca "Becky" Hunt Lumadue, 61, of Mooresville, passed away on Tuesday, December 12, 2017. She was born on October 3, 1956 in Charlotte, NC, to Blanche Daniel Hunt and the late H. Ray Hunt. Becky was a loving wife, mother and friend, her greatest joy was her two sons, Kenny and Patrick. Becky grew up in Charlotte, moved with her family to Littleton, CO in 1990, where they resided for 25 years prior to moving back to North Carolina in 2015.
