Robert “Bobby” Marshall Christie, 75, of Mooresville, passed away on Thursday, September 3, 2020 at his residence following a courageous battle with acute leukemia.

He was born on February 19, 1945 in Iredell County, NC, to the late Harvey and Lucy Corriher Christie. Mr. Christie was a member of Williamson’s Chapel United Methodist Church in Mooresville. He served as secretary and treasurer of the Shepherd Volunteer Fire Department, where he was a volunteer for over 40 years. Bobby worked for Draymore Manufacturing until they closed and then worked at Ingersol Rand in the shipping and receiving department in Davidson and Mocksville until his retirement. His motivators were his family, church, fire department, and his work. His grandchildren were his life.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a granddaughter, Madison Moody; brothers, Joe, Tom, and Carl Christie; sisters, Ruby Edmiston, Betty Saunders, and Lena Freeland.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Patsy Travis Christie; daughters, Lisa Christie Millsaps (Brent), Amy Christie Moody (Steve); grandchildren, Bailey Moody and Tristan Millsaps; and sisters, Pat Morrison, Linda Moody (Richard).
