Mr. Gregory, born December 28, 1930 in Pomaria, SC, son of the late Will Gregory and Belle Harmon Gregory, died June 22, 2021. He married the former Gerry Ann Hammond on October 11, 1952. Mr. Gregory was a 1953 graduate of the University of South Carolina School of Pharmacy. His career began at Hawthorne Pharmacy in Columbia, SC. and in 1961, he took a position at Goodman Drug in Mooresville, NC and spent the remainder of his forty plus year career with Revco Drug at various Mooresville locations.
