Robert Joseph "Bob" Gido, 54, of Mooresville, passed away on Saturday, February 3, 2018, at his residence. Born January 28, 1964, in Erie, PA, he was a son of Judith C. and George N. Gido. Bob was a graduate of Girard High School, Girard, PA, and Penn State College. While attending school, Bob worked for Koppers, a plant that converted coal to coke and was his first exposure to the coal industry. After graduation, he moved to the Charlotte, NC area and worked for a short time as a Design Engineer for Datasouth. In 1988 he joined Scandura, Inc. a conveyor belt manufacturer. Scandura was later acquired by Fenner. Bob traveled extensively visiting mines as a Sales and Application Engineer and valued the many friendships he made along the way and the experiences of a lifetime. Bob's family was always his top priority. Bob was an avid hunter and loved to boat, fish, garden, and play guitar. He was a member of Saint Mark's Lutheran Church. He was preceded in death by paternal grandparents, John and Anna Antolik Gido , and maternal grandfather, Anthony Pregler. In addition to his mother, father and grandmother, Frances Pregler, of Fairview, PA, he is survived by his wife, Susan "Susie" Haught Gido; children, Dylan Garner Gido and Hayden Robert Gido of Mooresville, NC and a brother, Tom Gido also of Fairview .
