Robert John Mack, "Bob", 88, of Mooresville, peacefully went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, February 12, at home in the company of his family.

He was born October 13, 1936, in Chicago, Illinois, son of the late Edmund and Mary Mack. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Dorothy Byrne.

Even as he got older, he could still be found playing on the floor, reading books, and being silly to make the kids laugh. Bob appreciated outings with his family, whether it was a trip to the aquarium, a museum, the zoo, or the science center. He also enjoyed driving his boat around the lake with family and friends and going out to eat for a fish dinner or a steak (with milk to drink!). He will always be remembered as a devoted and loving father, grandfather, and great-grandfather.
