Roger Allen Sweezy, 69, of Mount Ulla, passed away on Tuesday, August 5, 2014 at Novant Health Medical Center in Charlotte.

Mr. Sweezy attended NC State University, where he played football and later received his bachelor's degree from Catawba College in Salisbury. His best memory was being with Madison cheering on J.R. at the Super Bowl last year.
