Ronald Anthony Chislaghi, 82, of Mooresville, passed away on Saturday, March 12, 2022, at Brookdale Peachtree, Statesville. Born May 3, 1939, in Monongahela, PA, he was a son of the late Hugo and Irma Bercini Chislaghi. Mr. Chislaghi was a graduate of Slippery Rock University, Slippery Rock, PA, and earned his master's degree from Appalachian State University, Boone, NC. 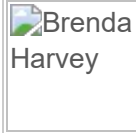
