Rosa Mitchell Guerke of Mooresville, North Carolina passed away on August 4, 2017. Rosa was born in Baltimore, Maryland on March 21, 1922. In 1940, Rosa married Ralph Martis Guerke. The two of them settled in Cedar Grove, New Jersey, where they lived in the same home on Franklin Street for 64 years until relocating to Mooresville, North Carolina in order to be closer to family. At the age of 40, Rosa went back to college to earn her Bachelor degree. She then went on to teach elementary students for over 20 years. Never one to sit idle, Rosa was a fixture within the Cedar Grove community, serving as President of the Junior Women's Club, the Garden Club and PTA. Additionally, Rosa served as Vice President of the Board of Education for nine years, during which time she oversaw the building of four elementary/middle schools and one high school.
