Sarah "Tink" Casey Wilkinson, 92, of Mooresville, NC, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October 14, 2025, at Cadence Mooresville, surrounded by her loving family. Born on May 4, 1933, in Wilkes County, NC, she was the cherished daughter of the late John William and Maud Howard Casey. Tink lived a life rich in love and devotion, embodying the roles of wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother and aunt with grace and steadfastness. Her unwavering dedication to her family was evident in her years of hard work at Cascade Mills, Home Curtain and 24 years of PTA.
