Born on July 13, 1942, in Baltimore, Maryland, Sharon's family soon returned to their roots in Mooresville. She grew up in a close-knit community and attended Mooresville Senior High School, where she met the love of her life, Norman Elmer Wilson, Jr., affectionately known as "Willie." They were married on February 8, 1958, and together they embarked on countless adventures as a United States Air Force family before returning to Mooresville to lay down roots.

Sharon was a uniquely giving and selfless person, whether you were a stranger, a friend, or family. She loved anyone she met completely and deeply. She always found the good in everyone and everything. Her life revolved around her family, her church, and her friends.
