Steven Lee Shoe, 74, of Mooresville, NC, passed away on Monday, June 1, 2020, at his home. He was born on October 9, 1945, in Salisbury, NC to the late Walter Lee Shoe and Velma Lillian Cress Shoe. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by his first wife, Margaret S. Shoe. He proudly served his country in the US Army in Korea during the Vietnam era. He was a graduate of Appalachian State University. Steve was in the banking business for over 20 years and began his career with Piedmont Bank. He was a real estate agent at Knox Realty for many years and manager of Mooresville ABC Store. He was a member of St. Mark's Lutheran Church. 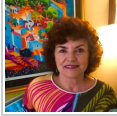
