Susan Budnick was a loving mother, grandmother, great grandmother and friend. She left this world suddenly on July 18, 2024, at age 77.

Susan was born in Providence, Rhode Island to Louis F. Wright and Virginia (Crowell) Wright on April 19, 1947. After graduating from Cranston East High School, she attended nursing school at Montgomery Hospital in Norristown PA, graduating in 1968. She began her career caring for the mentally ill in a state psychiatric hospital in RI. She then moved on to elder care, working her way up to director of nursing at several nursing homes. Later, she moved to Philadelphia and specialized in addiction/detox treatment, finishing her nearly four-decade career at Mercy Catholic hospital.

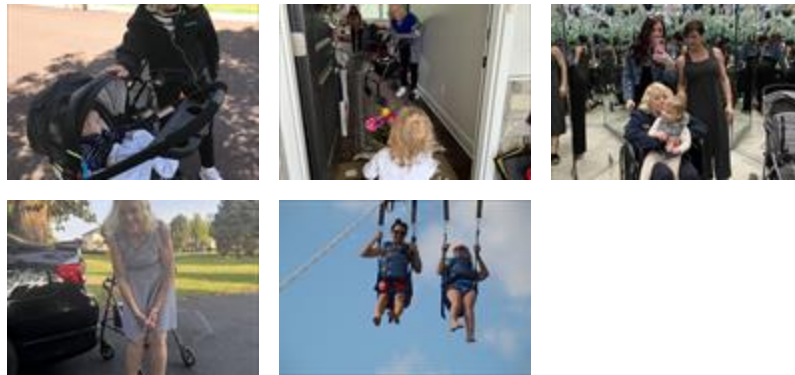

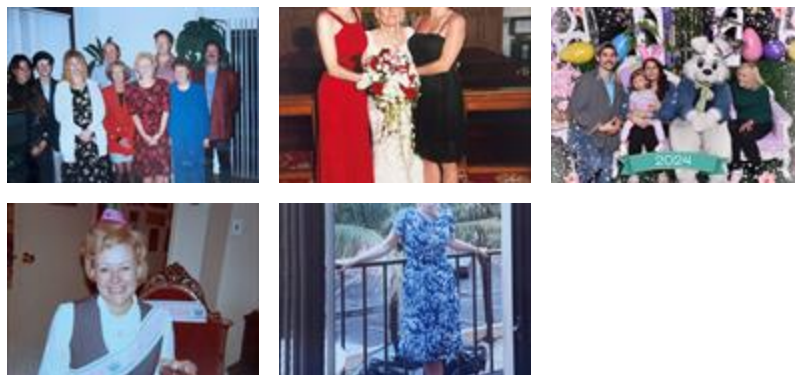
