It is with heavy hearts that our family shares the loss of our beloved husband, father, brother, grandfather, and great-grandfather, Thomas "Tommy" Moody Knox.

Tommy, 86, from Mooresville, NC was accepted into the arms of our Lord and Savior on January 30, 2024.

He was born in Mooresville on December 20, 1937, to the late Dwight Moody Knox and Mildred Cashion Knox. He graduated from Mt. Ulla High School in 1956 where he was a proud member of the baseball team.
