Tommy Lee Hartsell, 86, of Mooresville, NC, passed away on Wednesday, February 21, 2024, at Atrium Health, Charlotte.

He was born January 4, 1938, in Gaston County, to the late Warren Lee Hartsell and Sarah Elizabeth Hart Hartsell. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Patrick Allen Hartsell.

Tommy was a computer engineer for Duke Energy (formerly Duke Power Co.) for 33 years before his retirement. He proudly served his country in the US Air Force. He was an honor graduate of Mt. Holly High School, graduating second in his class. Tommy was a member and Past Master of Mooresville Masonic Lodge #496 AF & AM, a member of the Eastern Star, and Oasis Shriners.
