July 11, 1916 - July 13, 2017

J. Vaughn Boone, age 101, passed away on July 13, 2017. He was born in Greensboro on July 11, 1916 and moved to Saxapahaw area outside of Graham in Alamance County where he grew up.

Vaughn was a World War II veteran and a graduate of High Point University. He was well known and respected in the textile and dyestuff industry. In the 1960's, he started his own company melody Chemicals which later became Melatex, Inc. and still operates in Charlotte.

Vaughn is survived by his wife, Mary Ruth Dobbins; his daughter, Jaye B. Lawrence; his son, Warren Boone (Marchia) along with one granddaughter, Christen and two great grandchildren, Vinnie and Camway. Vaughn is also survived by his brother, TC Boone of Graham.

The service to honor Vaughn will be held at Unity Church, 108 Hewes Street, Winston Salem, NC 27103 on Saturday, August 12 at 11:00 AM.
