Victor Ansley Garrett, husband, father, recent grandfather, and friend passed away peacefully on March 4 following a recent illness. He is survived by his wife, Terri, daughter Brittany (Stephen), son Troy (Darby), and grandson Bennett.

Born in Decatur, Georgia, Vic moved to Charlotte as a toddler and later graduated from South Mecklenburg High School, where he met his future wife, Terri. After attending Wingate University, the two married and built a life together, celebrating their 40th wedding anniversary this past December. Vic was known for his loyalty and dedication to the many friendships he maintained throughout his life, from elementary school and college to adulthood. Professionally, Vic worked for more than 20 years with P.C. Godfrey Inc., before serving as the Assistant Athletic Director for the town of Mooresville until his retirement.

A lifelong outdoorsman, Vic loved fishing and hunting and enjoyed both whenever he could. He was also a devoted fan of the Georgia Bulldogs and followed them faithfully throughout his life. One of Vic's greatest passions was coaching youth sports, and he made a lasting impact on the lives of many young athletes through football and baseball.

Vic was preceded in death by his parents, Ken and Doris.
