Virginia Dare Archer Childress, 87, of Mooresville, passed away on Tuesday, December 29, 2020, at Novant Health Huntersville Medical Center. Born July 31, 1933, in Mecklenburg County, NC, she was a daughter of the late Earl McNeer Archer and Effie Lee Stutts Archer. Virginia retired as the Head Teller for Bank of America Mooresville Main Branch after over 58 years of service.
