Wayne Lee Fetty, 71, of Mooresville, NC, passed peacefully on Thursday, February 8, 2018. He was born on December 10, 1946, in New Martinsville, WV, to the late Lee and Imogene Staley Fetty. Mr. Fetty was a retired school teacher, who loved his career and his students. He also loved coaching basketball, track, and cross country, having won National Coach of the Year and many state championships with his cross country teams. He loved the Lord and his family and enjoyed fishing and hunting. Mr. Fetty was a member of Believers Faith Center in Statesville. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Carolyn Cork. He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Nancy Newcome Fetty; children, JoEllen Price (Jon) of Mooresville, NC, Erik Fetty of Charlotte, NC; brothers-in-law, Richard Newcome of Mebane, NC, Howard Cork of Pine Grove, WV; grandchildren, Jackson, Carter, and Grace Price; and numerous nieces and nephews. The family will receive friends on Saturday, February 10 from 1:00-3:00 PM with a service following at 3:00 PM at Cavin-Cook Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Mike Bivens officiating.
