



Rev. Weldon Junior Key

January 31, 1925 - November 1, 2018

Rev. Weldon Junior “Whick” Key, 93, of Mooresville, completed his Spiritual Race on Thursday, November 1, 2018.

He was born January 31, 1925 in Wilkes County, NC, to the late Alexander and Alice Brown Key. Mr. Key was a World War II veteran and became a believer in the Lord Jesus Christ at age 26. Afterwards, he became an ordained minister and preached in various churches. In addition, he founded two and completed the building programs in each. They were the First FWB of China Grove, NC and First FWB of Landis, NC. A devoted Christian sharing in gospel with many and always passing out gospel tracks. He had a special burden for Foreign Missions and support works through his own personal giving (much from the sell of cans and metal scraps) in addition to what was channeled through his pastorates. Only Heaven knows how much good was done through his efforts.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Wilma Chapman Key; and six brothers.

He is survived by his daughter, Nancy Pauley and husband, Rev. James Pauley; sister, Gladine Nance; grandson, Andrew Pauley and wife, Marie; and great grandchildren, Nolan and Andi Pauley.

The family will receive friends on Saturday, November 3 from 11:00-12:45 pm with a service following at 1:00 pm at Faith Baptist Church, Kannapolis, with Rev. James M. Pauley and Rev. Chuck Overcash officiating. Burial will follow the service at Carolina Memorial Park in Concord.

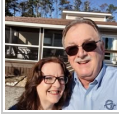
