William Marcus Coble, 87, of Mount Pleasant, South Carolina, and a former longtime resident of Mooresville, NC, entered eternal rest Thursday, June 29, 2023. His graveside service with military honors will be held Monday, July 3, 2023, in Mooresville's Glenwood Memorial Park at 11:00 am.

Marc was born September 24, 1935, in Mooresville, North Carolina, son of the late Scott Brown Coble and the late Maggie Sue Stiles Coble. He graduated from Mt. Ulla High School, Mt. Ulla, NC, in 1953. He then joined the U.S. Air Force where he served for 22 years, before retiring in May 1976, having earned the rank of Master Sergeant.
