William Ronald "Ron" Davidson, Sr., 77, of Mooresville, passed away peacefully on Monday, September 30, 2024, at Novant Health Huntersville Medical Center.

He was born on July 19, 1947, in Norfolk, VA, to the late Charles Cephus Davidson and Marietta Johnson Davidson. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Virginia W. Davidson; his granddaughter, Nadia Jenae Davidson; and his brother, Thomas Davidson.
